



The Government Media Office publishes an update on the most important statistics on the genocide committed by the Israeli occupation in the Gaza Strip on the occasion of two full years (730) days since the genocide began (from Saturday, October 7, 2023, to Sunday, October 5, 2025).

#### First: Population data and general context:

(2.4+) ♦ million people in the Gaza Strip are subjected to genocide, starvation, and ethnic cleansing.

(730) ♦ Days - two years (of genocide and ethnic cleansing against civilians.

(≈90%) ♦ Percentage of total destruction caused by the occupation in the Gaza Strip.

(80%+) ♦ Of the Gaza Strip's area has been controlled by the occupation through invasion, fire, and displacement.

(136) ♦ Times the occupation bombed the Al-Mawasi area, which it claims is a "safe humanitarian zone."

(200,000+) ♦ tons of explosives dropped by the occupation on the Gaza Strip.

#### Second: Martyrs, missing persons, and massacres:

(76,639) ♦ Total number of martyrs and missing persons since the start of the genocide.

(67,139) ♦ Total number of martyrs who arrived at hospitals since the start of the war of extermination.

(9,500) ♦ Missing, including martyrs still under the rubble or whose fate remains unknown.

(20,000+) ♦ Number of child martyrs who have arrived at hospitals. (19,450+)

(12,500+) ♦ Number of female martyrs who have arrived at hospitals. (10,160+)

(9,000+) ♦ Number of female martyrs.

(22,426) ♦ Number of fathers killed.

(1,015) ♦ Children under the age of one who were killed.

(450+) ♦ Infants born and killed during the genocide.

(1,670) ♦ Medical personnel killed by the Israeli occupation.

(140) ♦ Civil defense martyrs killed by the Israeli occupation.

(254) ♦ Journalists killed by the Israeli occupation.

(176) ♦ Municipal employees in the Gaza Strip, including (4) mayors.

- (787+) ♦ Martyrs from the police and aid workers killed by the Israeli occupation.
- (894) ♦ Martyrs from the sports movement in all sports.
- (39,022+) ♦ Families subjected to massacres by the Israeli occupation.
- (2,700+) ♦ Families wiped out and erased from the civil registry (8,574 martyrs).
- (6,020+) ♦ Families wiped out, with only one survivor remaining (12,917 martyrs).
- (55%) ♦ Of the martyrs are children, women, and the elderly.
- (460) ♦ Martyrs due to hunger and malnutrition, including (154) children.
- (23) ♦ Martyrs due to the wrong air drops of aid.
- (42%) ♦ Kidney patients lost their lives due to lack of food and healthcare.
- (12,000+) ♦ Miscarriages among pregnant women due to lack of food and healthcare.
- (17) ♦ Martyrs due to cold weather in forced displacement camps, including 14 children.

### Third: Injuries, arrests, and humanitarian cases:

- (169,583) ♦ Total number of wounded and injured who arrived at hospitals.
- (19,000+) ♦ Total number of wounded in need of long-term rehabilitation.
- 18% children.
- (4,800+) ♦ Total number of amputations, including
- (1,200) ♦ Total cases of paralysis.
- (1,200) ♦ Total number of cases of blindness.
- (433) ♦ Total number of journalists injured.
- (6,700+) ♦ Civilians arrested since the start of the genocide.
- (362) ♦ Number of medical personnel arrested.
- (48) ♦ Number of journalists arrested.
- (26) ♦ Number of civil defense personnel arrested.
- (21,193) ♦ Total number of war widows (whose husbands were killed).
- (56,348) ♦ Total number of orphaned children (children without one or both parents).
- 2,142+) ♦ million people infected with various infectious diseases as a result of forced displacement.
- (71,338+) ♦ Cases infected with hepatitis.

#### Fourth: Health sector:

- (38) ♦ Hospitals bombed, destroyed, or put out of service by the occupation.
- (96) ♦ Health care centers bombed, destroyed, or put out of service by the occupation.
- (197) ♦ Ambulances targeted by the Israeli occupation.
- (788) ♦ Attacks on health care services (facilities, vehicles, personnel, supply chains).
- (61) ♦ Civil defense vehicle (rescue and firefighting) targeted by the Israeli occupation.

#### Fifth: Education and academic institutions:

- (95%) ♦ of schools in the Gaza Strip suffered material damage as a result of bombing and destruction.
- (90+) ♦ of school buildings need to be rebuilt or undergo major rehabilitation.
- (668) ♦ School buildings were directly bombed, (%80≈) of the total number of schools.
- (165) ♦ schools, universities, and educational institutions were completely destroyed by the occupation.
- (392) ♦ Schools, universities, and educational institutions partially destroyed by the occupation.
- (13,500+) ♦ Number of student martyrs killed by the Israeli occupation.
- (785,000+) ♦ Number of students deprived of education by the Israeli occupation.
- (830+) ♦ Teachers and educational staff killed by the Israeli occupation during the war.
- (193+) ♦ Scientists, academics, and researchers killed by the Israeli occupation during the war.

#### Sixth: Places of worship and cemeteries:

- (835+) ♦ Mosques completely destroyed by the Israeli occupation.
- (180+) ♦ Mosques partially destroyed by the Israeli occupation.
- (3) ♦ Churches targeted by the Israeli occupation more than once.
- (40) ♦ Cemeteries destroyed by the occupation out of a total of (60) cemeteries.
- (2,450+) ♦ Bodies of the dead and martyrs stolen by the occupation from cemeteries.
- (7) ♦ Mass graves established by the occupation inside hospitals.
- (529) ♦ Martyrs killed by the occupation and exhumed from mass graves inside hospitals.

#### • **Seventh: Housing, forced displacement, and shelter:**

- (268,000≈) ♦ Housing units completely destroyed by the occupation.
- (148,000≈) ♦ Housing units severely damaged by the occupation and rendered uninhabitable.
- (153,000≈) ♦ Housing units partially destroyed by the occupation.
- (288,000+) ♦ Palestinian families left homeless.
- (125,000+) ♦ Tents completely destroyed and uninhabitable out of a total of (135,000).
- (2≈) ♦ million civilians displaced due to forced displacement policies.
- (293) ♦ Shelters and forced displacement centers targeted by the occupation.

#### • **Eighth: Starvation and denial of aid and medical treatment:**

- (220) ♦ Days since the occupation completely closed all crossings into the Gaza Strip.
- (120,000+) ♦ Trucks carrying humanitarian aid and fuel prevented by the occupation from entering the Gaza Strip.
- (47) ♦ Food distribution centers targeted by the occupation as part of its starvation policy.
- (61) ♦ Aid and food distribution centers targeted by the occupation as part of its starvation policy.
- (540) ♦ Initiators and workers in the field of aid and relief killed by the occupation.
- (128) ♦ Number of times the occupation targeted aid convoys and humanitarian shipments.
- (2,605) ♦ martyrs, (19,124) wounded, and (200+) missing in "death traps," called "US/Israeli aid" centers and aid seekers.
- (650,000) ♦ Children are at risk of death due to malnutrition, hunger, and food shortages.
- (40,000) ♦ Infants "under one year old" threatened with starvation due to a shortage of baby formula.
- (250,000) ♦ cans of milk needed by children in the Gaza Strip each month are prevented from entering by the occupation.
- (22,000+) ♦ Patients in need of treatment abroad, prevented from traveling by the occupation.
- (5,200+) ♦ Children in need of urgent medical evacuation to save their lives.
- (17,000+) ♦ Patients who have completed the transfer procedures and are waiting for the occupation to allow them to travel.
- (12,500) ♦ Cancer patients facing death and in need of treatment.
- (350,000) ♦ Chronic patients are at risk because the occupation prevents the entry of medicines.
- (3,000) ♦ Patients with various diseases who need treatment abroad.



(107,000≈) ♦ Pregnant and breastfeeding women at risk due to lack of healthcare.



#### Ninth: Infrastructure and public facilities:

(725) ♦ Central water wells destroyed and rendered inoperable by the Israeli occupation.

(134) ♦ The occupation targeted the water supply system, killing  
(9,400+) martyrs, most of them children.

(5,080) ♦ Kilometers of electricity networks destroyed by the occupation.

(2,285) ♦ Number of overhead and underground electricity distribution transformers destroyed by the occupation.

(235,000) ♦ Number of subscriber meters destroyed by the Israeli occupation.

(2,123+) ♦ Billion kilowatt-hours, the amount of electricity deprived from the Gaza Strip during the war.

(700,000+) ♦ meters of water networks destroyed by the occupation.

(700,000+) ♦ meters of sewage networks destroyed by the occupation.

(3+) ♦ Million linear meters of road and street networks destroyed by the occupation.

(247) ♦ Government buildings destroyed by the Israeli occupation.

(292) ♦ facilities, playgrounds, and sports halls destroyed by the Israeli occupation.

(208) ♦ Archaeological and heritage sites targeted by the Israeli occupation.

#### Live: Agriculture, livestock, and fisheries:

(94%) ♦ Of the agricultural land destroyed by the occupation out of a total of 178,000 dunams.

(1,223) ♦ Agricultural wells destroyed and put out of service by the Israeli occupation.

(665) ♦ Cattle, sheep, and poultry farms destroyed by the Israeli occupation.

(93,000+) ♦ dunams of land cultivated with vegetables have been reduced to (4,000).

(85%) ♦ of greenhouses destroyed in the Gaza Strip governorates.

(405,000) ♦ tons of annual vegetable production declined to only (28,000) tons.

(100%) ♦ of fish stocks were damaged as a result of the occupation targeting fishing areas.

#### Eleventh: Initial direct losses to 15 vital sectors:

\$70 billion in total initial direct losses from the genocide.

≈) ♦ \$5 billion total initial losses to the health sector.

≈) ♦ \$4 billion total initial losses to the education sector.

≈) ♦ \$28 billion total initial losses for the housing sector.

≈) ♦ \$1 billion total initial losses to the religious sector.
